

Bali Tote.... from Batik Textiles



* This pattern uses 5- ½ yard cuts of 5 different fabrics from the Bali Box group from BATIK TEXTILES . There are Prints..blenders /tone-on-tones .The layout & instructions are for the sample shown. Blenders and tone-on-tones are interchangeable in other colorways. When using different fabrics...make sure there is plenty of contrast between Blenders/tone-on-tones and prints for the front motif. * Use Annie's Soft and Stable or Pellon Fusible Fleece to give the tote and handles body. 1 yard is plenty. If you want extra body-cut fusible for lining too –2 yards needed then.

Cutting instructions:

Print # 1---cut 4-2 ½" squares(front motif) * see note (#2134) cut 1-18"X18" square (back) cut 2-4 ½"X10" (front motif side borders) cut 2-4 ½"X18" (front motif top and bottom borders)

Print #2 -- cut 2-5"X27" (handles/straps) (#2135)

Print #3----- cut 1- 16"X36" (inside pockets) (#2136) cut 4- 4" squares (#2135)

Tone on Tone #1— cut 2-18"X18" (inside lining) (#6024) cut 2- 4"squares (front motif) (#8640) cut 4- 2" squares (front motif) (#8640)

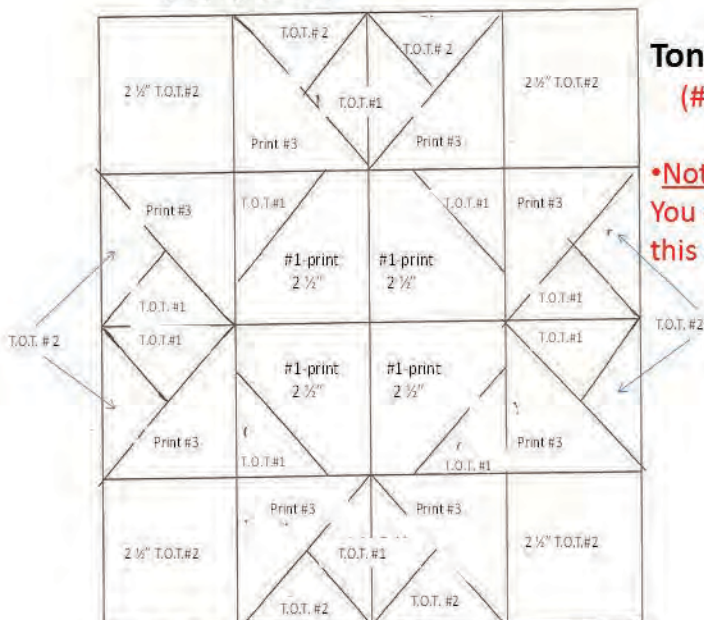
Tone on Tone #2—cut 4-2 ½"squares and 2-4"squares (#6024) (front motif)

•Note:

You can substitute a 4 ½"X4 ½" square for the center. I cut this from left over 4 ½" X 18" front motif side borders.
